EDT invests in long-term R&D partnerships for the development of new technologies that may provide leap ahead improvements to existing capabilities or new knowledge that helps identify opportunities for development of asymmetric capabilities for Defence.

Proposals are to be submitted by the Proposal Closing Time specified in clause 14.3 of the Conditions of Proposal.

ASCA will be holding a one-day Co-Design Workshop for the Decision Advantage RFP, Friday, 22 November 2024, in Canberra, ACT. This activity will be held both in person and virtually. Additional details will be provided once registrations are accepted.
